

THE FARM WAS BOUGHT IN 1948 BY JOHN (ROGER'S FATHER) AND PETER DENSHAM AS A RESULT OF A CHANCE ENCOUNTER BETWEEN PETER, WHO WAS AWAITING DE-MOB AT GRIMSDYKE CAMP (CURRENTLY GRIMSDYKE GRANARY) AND DOUGLAS MAIN WHO OWNED DAMERS FARM AT THE TIME. THE FARM WAS THEN KNOWN AS "LIME TREES AND DAMERS FARMS." THE LAND CARRIES 448 SHEEP RIGHTS ON MARTIN DOWN. LIME TREES COTTAGE AND DAMERS COTTAGE WERE BOTH PART OF THE FARM UNTIL 1981 AND 1998 RESPECTIVELY.
