

ALL SAINTS CHURCH

THE CHURCH DATES FROM C. 1100 WHEN IT WOULD HAVE BEEN A SMALL NORMAN CHURCH WITH THATCHED ROOF AND EARTH FLOOR.

POSSIBLY THE CHURCH WAS CRIGINALLY DEDICATED TO SAINT PETER AND SAINT PAUL. IN THE MIDDLE OF THE 19TH CENTURY THE CHURCH UNDERWENT EXTENSIVE RESTORATION, 'IT WAS IN A STATE OF DILAPIDATION ALMOST INDESCRIBABLE,' ACCORDING TO A LETTER WRITTEN BY THE REV. ALLNUTT, THEN VICAR OF DAMERHAM.
