

THOMAS SWEETAPPLE. IN 1672 THE HOUSE BELONGED TO DOROTHY HARRIS AND IT WAS LICENSED FOR PRESBYTERIAN WORSHIP. IN LIVING MEMORY THE HOUSE HAS BEEN A BAKERY. UNTIL 1992 RACEHORSES OWNED BY MRS. MITA EASTON WERE TRAINED AT HARRIS FARM BY MARK'S FATHER DARELL FARMER. THE HOUSE IS OF FOUR BAYS. THREE OF THESE ARE TIMBER FRAMED WITH HERRING-BONE BRICK IN-FILL. THE FOURTH BAY IS OF BRICK AND FLINT. THE PLAN FORM IS LOBBY ENTRY WITH THE DOOR IN LINE WITH THE CENTRAL CHIMNEY. THE HOUSE WAS THATCHED UNTIL THE MID '70s. THERE WAS A THATCHED TIMBER FRAME BARN BEHIND THE HOUSE UNTIL 1985.
