IN 1912 MR. THOMAS STREET, FARMER OF ST. ANDREW'S GUSSAGE, FARNHAM, SOLD 3 ROODS OF LAND AND A FLINT COTTAGE TO ABEN POORE OF MARTIN, WHO BUILT THE PRESENT HOUSE, PARTLY ON THE SITE OF THE OLD COTTAGE AND SUBSEQUENTLY NAMED IT CLOVELLY. THE HOUSE REMAINED IN THE OWNERSHIP OF THE POORE FAMILY FOR THE NEXT 80 YEARS. FROM THE PROPERTY THEY DEALT IN THE SERVICING AND REPAIR OF AGRICULTURAL MACHINERY. A LAY-BY WAS FORMED
