



BUSTARD FARM COTTAGES WERE, IN 1901, OCCUPIED BY FRENCH TRAPPIST MONKS WHO FARMED AT BUSTARD FARM AND KING'S FARM. THEIR CHAPEL WAS SITUATED AT A RIGHT ANGLE TO THE COTTAGES AND WHEN THE MONKS RETURNED TO FRANCE AFTER THE FIRST WORLD WAR IT WAS GIVEN BY THE LATE GEORGE WATERS TO THE CATHOLIC COMMUNITY AT BULFORD AND RE-ERECTED AS THE GARRISON CHURCH. IT IS SAID THAT, ABOUT TEN YEARS AGO, ONE OF THE MONKS RETURNED ON A VISIT TO THE AREA.
