

ONE TIME MAYOR OF SALISBURY (1762) WHOSE FAMILY HAD THE PROPERTY IN THE 18TH CENTURY, AND WHOSE VAULT IS IN THE LADY CHAPEL OF ALL SAINTS CHURCH. THE TAYLOR FAMILY OWNED THE PROPERTY FOR 50 YEARS UNTIL 1993 WHEN IT WAS SOLD TO THE PRESENT BOURCHIER FAMILY. ALAN TAYLOR AND HIS FAMILY RETAIN THE FARM AND HIS SON MIKE LIVES IN THE ADJACENT TALKS FARM COTTAGES. CLIVE AND CAROLYN BOURCHIER UNDERTOOK MAJOR RENOVATIONS OF THE BUILDINGS, WHICH HAD REMAINED UNOCCUPIED FOR THE LAST TWELVE YEARS OF MISS TAYLOR'S LIFE. SHE HAD LIVED AND RUN THE FARM WITH HER BROTHER SINCE THE 1930'S AND LEFT THE PROPERTY TO HER NEPHEWS.
