



## DENNETTS.

BRIAN RICHARDS HAS BEEN LIVING HERE FOR FOUR YEARS SINCE MOVING FROM BEACONSFIELD. HIS FATHER WAS BORN AND BRED AT BREAMORE. THE HOUSE WAS BUILT OF FLINT AND BRICK IN THE 1700s AS THE COACH HOUSE AND STABLES OF THE MANOR HOUSE. IN 1947 THE BUILDING AND A PARCEL OF LAND WAS BOUGHT BY HAROLD FRAMPTON, A FARMER, FOR THE SUM OF £900 AND LATER USED AS THE MILKING PARLOUR FOR HIS HERD OF CATTLE. THE CONVERSION TO THE PRESENT HOUSE WAS UNDERTAKEN BY HAROLD'S WIDOW, MABEL, IN THE EARLY 1980s.
