THE HOUSE WAS BUILT IN THE LATE 1960s BY HAROLD AND MABEL FRAMPTON. HAROLD FRAMPTON PREVIOUSLY LIVED AND FARMED AT AT GARRETT'S FARM. HIS HERD OF SHORT HORN DAIRY CATTLE CROSSED THE ROAD TWICE A DAY FOR MILKING IN THE BARN, NOW DENNETTS, WHICH MABEL FRAMPTON CONVERTED AFTER HAROLD'S DEATH AND THEN SOLD HANGERFIELD TO THE CHAPMANS.
