



### GARRETTS FARMHOUSE.

GARRETTS DERIVES ITS NAME FROM JOHN GARRETT WHO WAS A TENANT OF THE GLASTONBURY ESTATE IN THE 16TH CENTURY.

IN 1971 JOHN AND SALLY WILKINSON BOUGHT THE HOUSE FROM RICHARD SHEPHERD, BUILDERS IN FORDINGBRIDGE. IT HAD BEEN EMPTY FOR TWO YEARS AND WAS CONDEMNED, THEN THREATENED WITH DEMOLITION OR A 'NEO GEORGIAN' FACELIFT. IN 1972, AFTER MAKING THE HOUSE HABITABLE, JOHN AND SALLY MOVED IN WITH GILES, AGED 7 AND CLARE, AGED 5. A LATE MEDIEVAL MILLSTONE FOUND IN
