A VERY LARGE BREADOVEN AND EQUALLY LARGE COPPERS IN WHAT HAS BEEN CALLED THE BREW ROOM SUGGESTS MUCH ACTIVITY WHEN GARRETT'S WAS ONE OF THE LARGEST FARMS IN THE VILLAGE.
