



LIME TREES FARMHOUSE IS A LISTED GRADE II TIMBER FRAMED BRICK FARMHOUSE WITH A COB WALL DATING FROM THE EARLY 18TH CENTURY. IT WAS FORMERLY THATCHED. IN 1921 THE HOUSE WAS BOUGHT FROM THE EYRE COOTE ESTATE BY GEORGE WATERS OF TOYD. IN 1936 MR AND MRS DOUGLAS MAIN BOUGHT THE HOUSE AND SOLD 24 ACRES OF LAND IN 1948, FURTHER LAND IN 1960 AND 1972 (WHERE HARRIERS AND ARDCOUR ARE NOW SITUATED) AND FERN COTTAGE IN 1966. MIKE AND JENNY GAILLARD BOUGHT THE PROPERTY IN 1995 FROM MRS. MAY MAIN AND BEGAN AN EXTENSIVE RENOVATION. THEY
